International Business Management (IBM)

The **IBM** programme is for you who want to pursue a career in the increasingly global and international world of business and who want to study in English together with students from all over the world. The programme focuses on business administration with specialization on management issues with an international perspective. Communication, analytical ability, problem solving, and an innovative approach are central for you who are aiming for a leadership position. The IBM programme prepares you for a job as a manager, project leader, salesperson, HR or why not for starting your own business in a globalized market.

IBM started in 2004 and has over the years undergone changes both in terms of length and structure. In 2017 **IBM** was granted an **EFMD** accreditation, and a reaccreditation in June 2020 for five more years. EFMD Programme Accreditation System is an international accreditation system that evaluates business programmes at bachelor's and master's level. To be awarded this accreditation is an indication that the programme maintains high quality and stand up well from an international perspective.
